**Maurice “Born Unique” Askew** was born on July 20, 1971 to the late Ervin Askew and Dorothy Johnson.

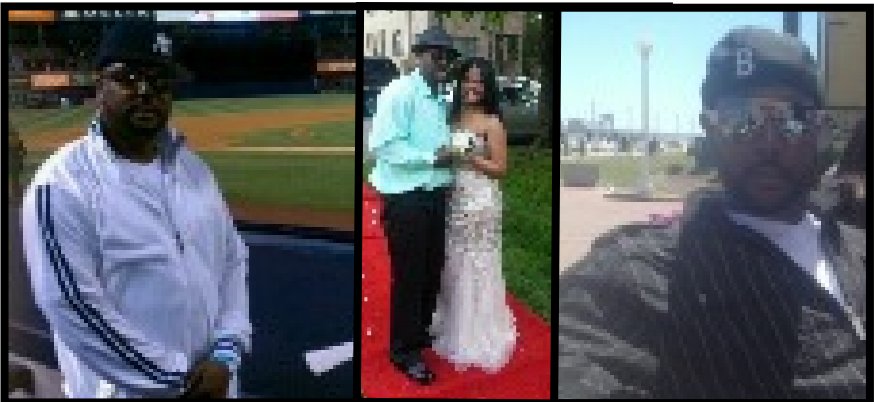
