Barbara Ann Chambliss was born on November 5, 1940 in Gastonia, North Carolina, daughter of Mamie Henry Williams and James Williams. Her family relocated to Roselle, New Jersey. She then moved to Linden, New Jersey where she graduated from Linden High School.

Barbara was employed as a clerical worker at Paul's Trucking in Avenel, New Jersey. She had previously worked for Griffith's Electronics in Linden, Deluxe Toy Factory in Elizabeth, New Jersey, Simmons Mattress in Linden and she worked in the Distribution Center at Supermarkets General in Edison, New Jersey.

In 1971 Barbara met William Charles Chambliss and on April 1, 1978, they were joined in holy matrimony. Together they would raise 5 children, Troy, Dani, Derrick, Charles and Nikki.

She was the First Lady and served with the Pastors Aide Committee of Greater Refuge Missionary Baptist Church in Newark, New Jersey where her beloved husband, William is the Pastor. During her 20 year membership at White Rock Baptist Church in Linden, she served as a Deaconess, Choir Member and was in charge of the Junior Ushers. She had also served with the Willing Workers during her 4 year membership at St. Paul Baptist Church in Elizabeth.

First Lady Chambliss departed this life on Wednesday, May 7, 2014 at home at the age of 73. She was predeceased by her parents, James and Mamie Williams; a daughter, Wanda Renee Williams; a sister, Katie Mae Dixon and a daughter-in-law, Katherine Hodge.
