Sturley Emanuel Brooks was born the 30,594th person within the community of Ritches, Clarendon, Jamaica W.I. to parents, Bishop Nehemiah U. Brooks and Melda I. Brooks (deceased) on June 8, 1942. He was the second son of six children.

On December 16, 1967, Sturley married his wife of forty-six years Marian Virginia McIntosh, daughter of Bishop Leonard McIntosh and Phyllis McIntosh. They were blessed with three wonderful children; son, Sterling O'Neil, daughter, Maria Bouvier and son, Marcel Dwayne.

Sturley worked as an insurance professional for Caribbean Atlantic Life Insurance Company. He was inducted into the Millionaire's Club for his achievements in policy sales. He also worked for Bauxite Company Alcan & Kirkvine. He pastored at the Apostolic Faith Churches in Spalding, Warsop and Bronte. After his migration to the United States in 1977, he continued within the insurance industry. He worked as an underwriter for New York Life. He lived in Brooklyn, NY where he served with the Church of The 1st Born. He went on to Pastor at the 14th St. East Orange Church.

In 1980 as an ordained minister, he founded Emanuel's Hope Baptist Church Incorporated, in Orange, NJ. He served with the Unified Free Will Baptist Churches as Pastor. He graduated from United Christian College in Brooklyn, NY, where he achieved the following; Certificate of The Psychology of Counseling United Christian College, April, 1984; Bachelor of Religious Education, United Christian College, April, 1984; Doctorate of Divinity United Christian College, March, 1985; Masters of Theology, United Christian College, April 1985.

With the challenge of family, ministry and work, he decided to leave his secular job to serve as full time pastor of Emanuel's Hope Baptist. Reverend Dr. Brooks experienced all the highs and lows ministry offers. His preaching brought countless souls to Christ. He performed many baptisms, weddings, funerals, ordinations and baby dedications. Like Jesus he had his cross to bear, but he endured all with the strength and courage given to him by his Lord and Savior Jesus Christ. Pastor Brooks would always say... "God needs a man to stand in the Gap and I am that man". Never wavering from his decisions, he was a champion for the growth of the kingdom of God. A Pastor beyond the borders of Emanuel's Hope Baptist Inc., his goal was to save and to send out workers into the field. Through his ministry many churches were formed. From Canada, the eastern seaboard of the United States and Jamaica, W.I., you will find members and former members of Emanuel's Hope Baptist Church, Inc.

Bishop Brooks was the General Overseer of Emanuel's Hope Restored Church of God Inc., Jamaica, W.I.

He gave his all. This is not death; it is GLORY!!!
