May was preceded in death by her brothers George A. McDonald, Harold K. McDonald and Joseph T. McDonald III.

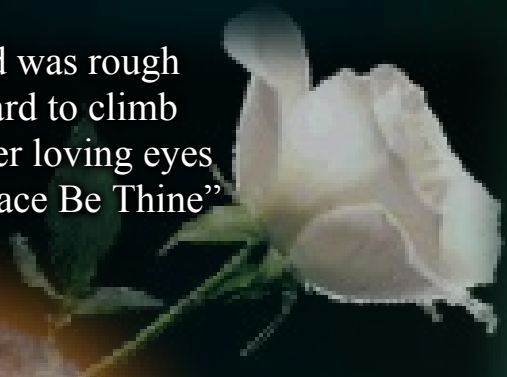
