Arnetta Louise Knight was born on July 13, 1926 in Portsmouth, Virginia, daughter of Bessie Jeffries Lassiter and Berlin Lassiter. Educated in the Portsmouth Public School system, she graduated from I. C. Norcum High School in Portsmouth. She would later attend classes at Saint Paul's Polytechnic Institute (now Saint Paul's College) in Lawrenceville, Virginia before moving to New Jersey in the mid-1950s.

Arnetta (affectionately known as "Net") was joined in holy matrimony to Alton Frederick Knight, Sr. and this union was blessed with two children, Alton Frederick Knight, Jr. and April Loi Knight. They would raise their family in Roselle, New Jersey.

Mrs. Knight had been employed as a Seamstress at Phoenix Manufacturing Company in Roselle, New Jersey for approximately 30 years before she retired.

She was a member of Heard A.M.E. Church in Roselle, New Jersey where she was active as a Sunday School teacher, director of the Male Chorus and member of the Emergency Choir. When not singing or directing on Sunday, she could be found in her customary seat in the pew near the back row.
