Reflections of Life

Monday, December 22, 1919 the late Arthur and Julia (Kennley) Johnson gave birth to a beautiful baby girl **Gertrude Mae** in St. Matthews, South Carolina.

She attended elementary and high school in St. Matthews, SC. She received a BA Degree in Elementary Education from Voorhees College, Denmark, SC in 1940. She later attended the William Paterson College, Rutgers the State University and Fashion Institute of Technology in NY.

Gertie met, courted and then united in holy matrimony to Walter Alfred Ross on Monday, December 22, 1941. To this union God bestowed two daughters, Jervine Blacks of Snellville, GA and Janet Althea Ross of Passaic.

Grandma was employed by Allegra Tech Inc. as an Operator Tester, Catholic Family Services as a Senior Outreach Worker, a Elementary School Teacher and also was the Proprietor of Ross Knits and Things Passaic.
