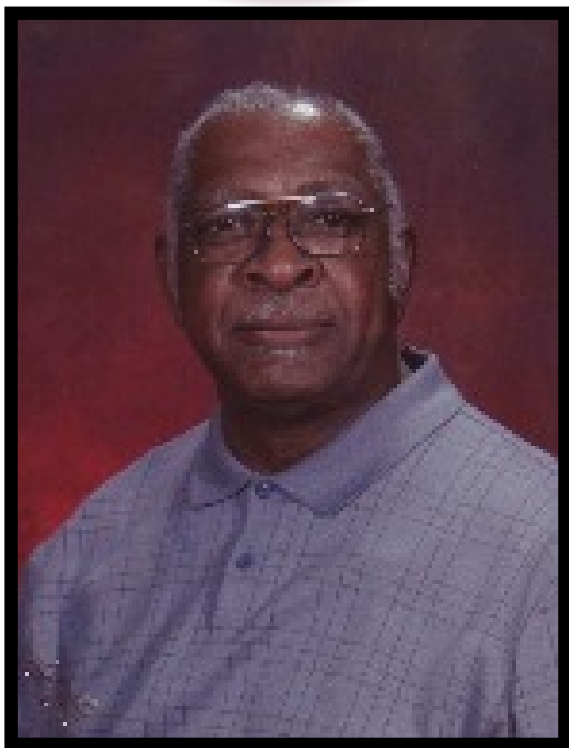

Obituary
