**Eva Milligan** was born on February 10, 1912 in Colleton County Township of Bells in Ruffin, South Carolina, daughter of Bertha Atkinson Adams and Zena Adams. In 1924, Eva's family relocated to Mt. Union, Pennsylvania. They remained there until 1927, when they moved to Linden, New Jersey.

While living in Linden, she met the love of her life, Raymond Thomas Milligan. They were joined in holy matrimony and this union was blessed with seven children, Ruth, Edward, Rose, Richard, Raymond, Jr., Dennis and Jackie. Eva and Raymond would raise and educate their family in Linden and remained residents there until they both passed away.

Mother Milligan had been active in the Linden community throughout her life. She was active with the Boy Scouts of America and in her church. She was one of the founders of Mt. Moriah Baptist Church in Linden where she served on the Usher Board for many years. She was recently honored by being named Mother of the Church and on Sunday, September 15, 2013, she was acknowledged as being the oldest member of the church.

Although Eva had been employed on a few short term jobs outside of the home, she enjoyed being a homemaker and taking care of her family the most.

In 1980, Eva lost her eyesight due to glaucoma. Despite her handicap, she managed to care for herself in her home. Two of her favorite past times were talking on the phone with her friends and relatives and listening to her favorite baseball team, the New York Yankees on the radio.

Last year at the family reunion in Columbia, South Carolina, she was acknowledged as the oldest living member of the Adams Family.

Mother Eva Milligan departed this life on Friday, August 22, 2014 at Trinitas Hospital in Elizabeth, New Jersey at the age of 102. She was predeceased by her beloved husband, Raymond Milligan in 1991 and 3 children, Raymond, Jr., Dennis and Jackie.
