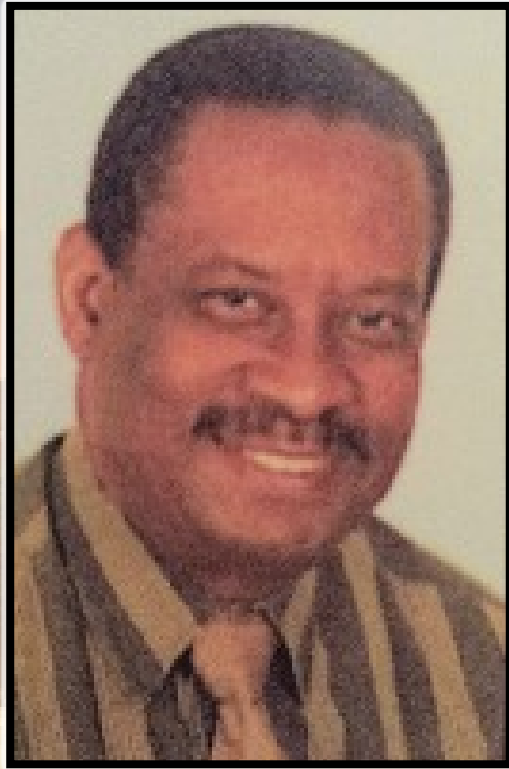

Obituary

James H. Greene was born on March 22, 1943 on the island of Montserrat to the late Jain and Arthur Greene. He attended the elementary and secondary schools of Montserrat with his siblings. He was also active member in the Anglican Church.

James, who was always intelligent and ambitious, loved the waters, fishing, dominoes, cricket and family. James being fearless and wanting more in life, decided to leave Montserrat and explore his dreams in New York City, in the late 1960's. James lived in New York City for fifteen years, before moving to California and it was there, he realized his dreams of receiving a bachelor's and master's degree, in Economics at California State University. James stayed in California State, to become a professor, teaching economics and African studies. James also became an advisor and served as program director for student services/educational opportunity, in the school of health and human development. However, James realized that this would not be possible, if it had not been for the Lord.

James became a member of Ever Increasing Faith Ministries at Crenshaw Christian Center in Los Angeles, Ca, under the Pastor Frederick K. Price. James, was so touched by the Lord, he started a Christian website in California State that gave teachers and students a platform to spread the good news about God, local and abroad. God would later elevated James to higher heights to write two books "The chosen tree and on the way to paradise". In 2002, James left the Crenshaw Christian Center to become a member of Spirit Food Christian Center in Woodland Hills, California, under the Pastor Garry D. Zeigler. James, in spite of his success, would never let an opportunity go by, without telling a friend, family or stranger about the goodness of the Lord, even until his health began to fail him in 2005.

James would later retire and moved to New Jersey, in 2006. In that time, James attended both Union Baptist Church in Morristown, NJ and later Love of Jesus Family Church in Orange NJ, while struggling with his health. In that time, James walked with a "Job spirit", enjoying his family and regular worships, until his health took a turn for the worst on February 18, 2014. James made his transition, on August 26, 2014 at Alaris Health St. Mary's Nursing home.

James leaves to cherish his memory, two daughters Margaret Pod Grant of Tortola, WI, Jennifer Greene-Boykin (Kenneth) of New York City. Two Sons, Devon Brooks (Michelle) of Orange, NJ and Gerard Greene (Florence) of North Haven, Connecticut. Two sisters, Diane Weeks of London, England and Auntie Greene of Antigua, WI. Twelve grand-children, two great-grandchildren, Host of nephews, nieces and other relatives.
