James Allen Williams, Sr. was born on May 7, 1933 in Chester, S.C., to James Odell Williams and Vergie Ree Kennedy. His schooling took place in Chester, S.C., where he graduated from Finnely High School. He furthered his education at Devry Technical Institute, and graduated in 1992 with a degree as a Master Mechanic.

James served in the Army from 1953 and 1955 and was deployed to Korea as an Artillery Specialist. For his service, James received a National Defense Service medal, Korean Service medal, United Nations Service medal, and a Good Conduct medal.

James married Marjorie Hayes in 1957, and to this union two children were born: James, Jr. and Crystal.

James was employed at Schering-Plough (Merck) for 39 years, and worked at both the Kenilworth and Union locations as a Packing Line Mechanic. He received a special award for having perfect attendance for over 30 years of service with Schering-Plough.

James was an active member of Aeon Baptist Church in Union, N.J. He received special recognition for his dedication to the church and the community, and was also recognized for being the oldest and the longest serving member of the church. James was also an active member of the Men's Choir and Men's Fellowship groups.

James enjoyed fishing, working on cars and woodworking. He was well known for his picture frames.

He departed this life on September 6, 2014. He was predeceased by his parents and two sisters: Virginia Stradford and Gertrude Stokes.
