Carlson L. Ervin was born to the union of Harry L. Ervin and Jennie (Lowe) Ervin on



September 18, 1933 in Newark, New Jersey. He departed this life Sunday, September 21, 2014 after a long illness.

Carlson was a longtime resident of Newark, NJ until his move to Watchung, NJ nine years ago.

He attended Westside High School, and Rutgers University. He graduated from Rutgers University in 1980 with a Bachelor's degree in Education.

He is predeceased by his parents, Mrs. and Mr. Harry L. Ervin; his sister, Mrs. Adrina Ervin-Brice; his son, Harry V. Ervin.

He was employed by U.S Metals Refining Company in Carteret, NJ for forty-five years as a pipefitter and mechanic; in addition he was a longstanding union representative for the

company. After his retirement from U.S. Metals, he went on to work for ten years at Passaic Valley Water Commission as a plumber, and retired in 1998.
