Obituary



Rev. James R. Sleboe was born on March 9, 1959 to the union of Bishop Richard Kanton Sleboe and Mary Sleboe in Harbel, Firestone, Margibi County.

Rev. Sleboe started his early education at the Harbel Elementary School, then his junior high at the Robert F. Okai Junior High School in Dolo's Town, Margibi County. After junior high, he enrolled at the Reginald Townson High School in Unification Town, Margibi County. After he completed high school, he started employment at the Robert International Airport as a security officer.

In 1980, he migrated to the United States of America. A few months later he met Catherine Robinson, and they were blessed with four children and six grandchildren. Rev. Slebo further earned his undergraduate and graduate degree

from Essex College in Criminal Justice Administration. Rev. Sleboe was a great source of support to family members back home in Liberia. He also impacted the lives of many people, even people he had no relationship with. He was always ready to help people. Rev. Sleboe was like a father to many young people. He touched their lives in many different ways.

The Lord called Rev. James Sleboe to sleep on the night of October 18, 2014 at 8:29 p.m. at the Clara Mass Hospital after a brief illness. Rev. Sleboe was preceded in death by his wife, Loretta Mark Sleboe, who passed away about five months ago.

He left behind: four children and three step children, Lakeisha, Sabrina, Tetee and Richard; six grandchildren, Shawn, Jakee, Alexus, Janiyah, Taniyah and Rahdeek; the step children are as followed, Rabiyyah, Sabriyah and Nabila; he also left behind two brothers and three sisters, Henry Sleboe of the United States, Tobey Sleboe, Deborah Nimley, Nelly Cooper and Everlyna Sleboe of the Republic of Liberia; and a host of other relatives, both in the United States and in Liberia.
