Reflections of Florence J. Jackson's Life

Florence Jacqueline Jackson was born in the Bronx New York on November 24, 1940 to Lois and George Timber. Jackie was the last of nine children.

Jackie graduated from Morris High School in the Bronx, New York, then went on to attend Bronx Community College where she earned her Associates Degree in Early Childhood Education and went on to attend City College in Manhattan continuing her education in Early Childhood.
