On Friday, October 24, 2014 at 11:00 A.M. **Mrs. Lister Griffin Sanders** was called to eternal rest at the Newark Beth Israel Medical Center located in Newark, New Jersey after a lengthy illness.

Mrs. Lister Griffin Sanders, a native of South Mills, North Carolina, was born on August 15, 1926. She was the daughter of the late Mr. Isaiah and Mrs. Emma Griffin. Lister was the youngest of seven (7) children; and her mother passed away when she was seventeen (17) month old. Her father raised his family surrounded by the simple pleasures of a loving family and farm life.

She received her early education at the Rosenwald School located in South Mills North Carolina.
