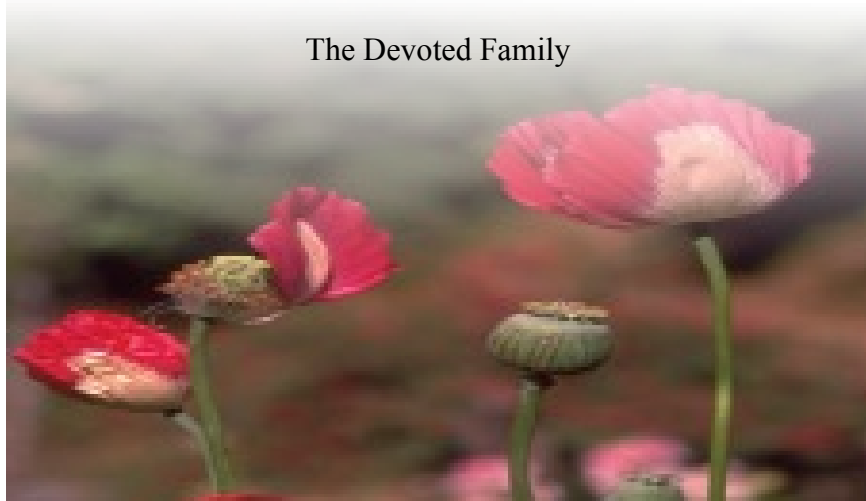
She was joined in marriage to Otha C. Smith, Jr. who preceded her in death. Of this union two children were born Otha and Kevin Smith.
