Sarah loved the art of making people beautiful, as we all saw in her make-up and hair. She looked beautiful whenever she went out, even if she left her place just to get a loaf of bread.

She resided in the Bronx for over 50 years, raising her youngest son during that time, Sean Michael Edwards; and being an encouraging grandmother to Tamika, Rodney, Elijah, Veronica, Byron, Sheila, Arnold and Curtis. She also spent her time creating a variety of beautiful arts and crafts, including artisan breads and desserts, handmade quilts, comforters, crocheted scarves, hats, afghans and caring for a host of plants, which she called "her babies". Her days were filled with the activities she enjoyed. Sarah read and maintained a collection of magazines, always looking to learn more, and expand her knowledge base.

During the last few decades, mom preferred to stay at home, in her apartment. To her, the world had become unsafe and frightening, it was better to stay home. She often would say, "I don't want any company", however she enjoyed our company when we went to see her and didn't want us to leave.

After a long illness that peaked earlier this year, she quietly and peacefully passed Friday morning, October 24, 2014, leaving a family that will greatly miss and always remember her, the beautiful Sarah Edwards.
