Gwendolyn Celestine Richardson, daughter of Marian Buie and Evander Dericot, was born on July 28, 1945 at Fordham Hospital in Bronx, NY. She departed this life on November 5, 2014. She was predeceased by her brother, Sgt. Isaac Michael Buie.

Gwen lived in Brooklyn, NY throughout her childhood and for much of her formative years. Concentric to her education, Gwen was raised in the Catholic faith, attending two catholic schools, St. Athanasius (elementary) and St. Teresa of Avila (secondary), both located in Brooklyn, NY.
