

# Eulogy

**Lovina Reid ("LOVIE")**, was born on November 3, 1927 in the parish of St. Ann, Jamaica, WI. She was the fourth child of six for Robert and Margaret Williams. As a child, Lovina and her family moved to New Gardens in the Parish of St. Andrew.

Lovina grew up to be a take charge woman who strived for the best for her family and friends. As a young woman, she moved to Kingston, Jamaica where she acquired a job at the Caribbean Preserving Company. There she also met her boss who later became her husband, Norman Reid who preceded her in death on October 14, 2007.

In 1963, Lovina migrated to the United States in Chicago, Illinois where she later settled in Brooklyn, New York. In 1967, Norman joined her in New York and together they forged ahead to bring their combined families together in the United States. For over 25 years Lovina worked as a Nurse's Aide for some of New York City's most prestigious clients and hospitals. Lovina and her husband eventually established a successful video rental store on Church Avenue which they both managed for over 15 years. In the early 2000s they decided to close the video store and enjoyed their retirement.

Lovina, was a stickler for hard work and cleanliness and was always known to have a bag full of mints which she offered to everyone. She was always fond of cooking and always made an effort to feed everyone until they couldn't move. Lovina loved the Lord and would rejoice in listening to gospel, her television was permanently fixed on TBN or the word channel. With love, she instilled in everyone the importance of being kind to each other.

In her later years, Lovina's health failed until she quietly slipped away in her sleep at home on November 30<sup>th</sup>, 2014. Lovina leaves behind a large family including her sister, Zetti in London; daughters, Cynthia, Paulette and Dorrette; step daughters, Norma and Lorna; stepson, Errol; 13 grandchildren, Natalie, Arlene, Yvette, Richard, Ricardo, Devon, Marcia, Carol, Nadine, Kenya, Imani, Leilani and Nicole; 29 great grandchildren, 5 great-great grandchildren, cousins and other relatives and friends.

Lovina was a loving wife, sister, aunt, mother, daughter, grandmother, cousin and friend. She will be deeply missed by those who knew her and are grateful that she was once a part of their lives.
