

Obituary

Townser was a loving father, who loved his children and family dearly. Many of his favorite pastimes were fishing with his sons and watching baseball games. He looked forward to attending family reunions in South Hill, VA, being with his family and hanging with his buddies. He had a jovial spirit and loved to crack jokes and make people laugh.

Townser, affectionately known as "Tee", was a sharp dresser who loved to sport his hats. He rarely ended a conversation without saying, "Keep in touch!" He will be deeply missed by all who knew him.


Townser unfortunately became ill and departed this life on Tuesday, December 9, 2014 at University Hospital in Newark, NJ.
