**Catherine Monica Bradley Smith** was born in New York City, into the family of John George Bradley and Theodosia Dasent Bradley on August 31, 1939.

Her earliest ambition was to become a concert pianist. She studied music under Mrs. H. Ross of Juilliard School of Music. Catherine had other creative talents. She was a creative designer. Her nephew, John still treasures his blazers and sports jackets that she made. Catherine also had business skills. Early on she became the bookkeeper for the family business.

In college, Catherine majored in accounting and was awarded a Bachelor's Degree in Business Administration. Her skills did not go unnoticed, she was recruited by General Motors' Corporate Headquarters, and later became an Account Executive, the only female and person of color in their overseas division. After the decline of General Motors, Catherine became an Office Associate in Health and Hospital Corporation at Metropolitan Hospital until she retired. There she met two great friends, Carmen and Juanita, who she kept in touch with until her death.

Catherine became a widow early in life. At Sacred Heart Roman Catholic Church she chaired the Parish Council, under Father Mark Cregan for several years. She was an active lecturer to the end, and could always be counted upon for deliverance with clarity and eloquence. She was often called upon to speak at special services at the Church and other religious institutions. And she was a special member of Sacred Heart Gospel Choir.

Catherine infused travel in her scheme of life. She traveled to every island in the Caribbean, then continued her travel to Africa, Europe, and China.

Catherine was never too busy to talk, to listen, to give advice, no matter the situation, Catherine's response was "no problem". She gave freely to her family, beloved church and friends. "La" was always there whenever and wherever needed. Catherine enjoyed life.

Catherine will be greatly missed by: her sisters, Faith and Joy; nephew, John and daughter, Hope; niece, Edith and family; brothers, Teodoro and George; cousins, Stedman, Fran, Marvin, Al and wife; relatives in St. Kitts and Nevis; and neighbors, Naomi and family, Carlos and family.
