A Time of Joy:

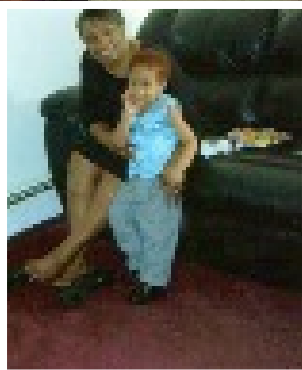

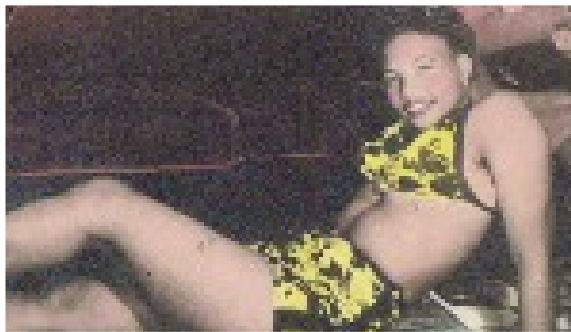
A Time of Peace:

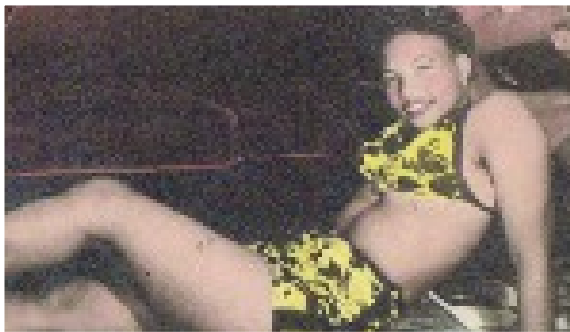
Cora was called to rest on Wednesday, December 24, 2014.

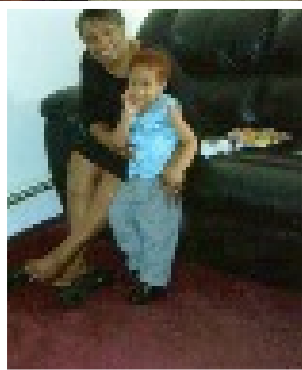
