Lorine Washington Rozier nicknamed "Sister", was born in Hawkinsville, GA on June 1, 1939 to the late Charlie Washington Sr. of Bleckley County, Ga and Varena Huguenia Washington of Pulaski County, Ga. She later moved from Hawkinsville, GA to Passaic, NJ before making Paterson, NJ her place of residence for 36 years.

At a young age she was introduced to Jesus Christ while attending Free Providence Baptist Church in Ga. She was member of the Hawkinsville High & Industrial School graduating class of 1959. She shown a caring spirit to all and was very passionate about family. Her greatest spiritual influence came from her mother Varena Huguenia Washington and her grandmothers Floretta Taylor Huguenia and Narcissa Tillman Washington. Her passion for family and love of teaching led her to a career in the field of early childhood for 17 years while working with the Concerned Parents Head Start Program in Paterson, NJ. She attended Passaic County Community College and Montclair State College to complete her Childhood Development Associate credentials. She continued her walk with God as a member of the Mount Moriah Baptist Church where she attended regularly and was a faithful choir member. With her health beginning to decline, she decided to relocate closer to her children for needed support. She was loved and respected by the staff and residents of the center.
