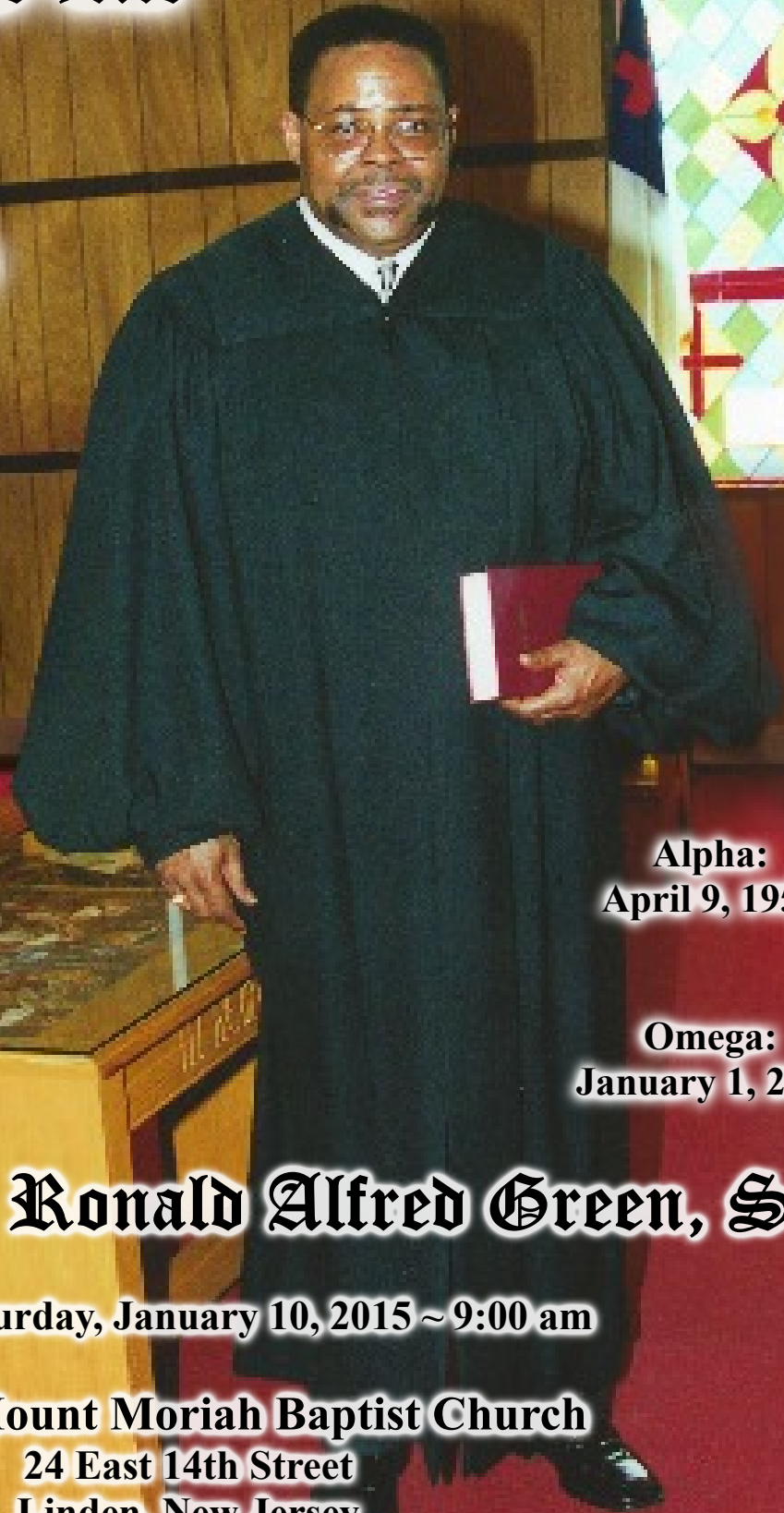

## Life Reflections

**Rev. Ronald Alfred Green, Sr.** was born on April 9, 1951 in Mead, West Virginia, son of the late Mr. Samuel Green, Sr. and Mrs. Mildred Green. He graduated from Stoco High School. His early Christian training was at St. Paul Baptist Church in Mead, West Virginia during that time he served as the Superintendent of Sunday school.

In 1976, Rev. Green was ordained as a Deacon and served on the board at Greater Mt. Moriah Baptist Church. He received the call to the ministry and was ordained in 1978 under the leadership of Rev. M. L. Frazier. He continued to study the word. He matriculated at the Northern Baptist School of Religion and Manhattan Bible Institute, receiving a Bachelor of Theology Degree.

Rev. Green was a member of Linden Interfaith Council. He was the former 2nd Vice Moderator-Chairman of the Permanent Council of the Middlesex Central Baptist Association of New Jersey. Rev. Green was a member of the Lott Carey Association and Director of the Greater Mount Moriah Childcare Center. He was a charter member of the Linden Rev. Dr. Martin L. King Commemorative Committee.

Rev. Green was always concerned about his members and the community. He spent hours in Christian service touching the lives of men, women, boys and girls throughout the area.

On Thursday, January 1, 2015, our beloved pastor received his angel wings at Robert Wood Johnson University Hospital in Rahway at the age of 63.

He was predeceased by his sister-in-law, Jacqueline Bowser.
