## **Mother Louise A. Letsinger**

On Monday, January 19, 2015, Jesus helped Mother Louise Letsinger to cross that last river into eternal rest.

Mother Louise Letsinger was born as Louise A. Johnson in Norfolk, VA, to the late Harry Bryant Johnson and Alma Jones on March 3, 1923. She was raised in Newport, VA, where she attended John Marshall Elementary School. She always talked about how times were back then and how she had to worked after elementary school.

On August 4, 1967, Mother Letsinger married the love of her life the Rev. Gilbert Letsinger.

She worked by his side as First Lady. Mother was known as a loving, caring, and sweet woman of God who always wanted to deposit nuggets of wisdom in everyone lives. Mother Letsinger was also known in the community as the “Lady at the Laundromat” at Mrs. Thomas' Laundromat on the corner of Sussex Ave. and Third Street in Newark. Mother also loved and worked for her extended family the Abrams/Simmons family who she cared for many years.

After the death of her husband in 1986, Mother Letsinger promised Pastor Rayam (a prophecy that came true) that if SDRT Church moved from Brooklyn, NY to Newark, NJ that she would join and work in the vineyard. She did just that! She worked as head of the Pastor's Aide Committee and earn her title as mother of the church. Mother was known at her tender age of "90 years old" as an energetic, loving, caring, full of laughter, and God-fearing Woman of God.
