# *Legacy of Life*

*Mrs. Beulah Mae Wiggins* was born to the proud parents of the late Norman and Lizzie (Ferrell) Richardson in Thompson, Georgia on October 23, 1929.

Beulah was raised in Washington, Georgia where she completed her formal education in the Washington School District and proudly received her High School Diploma.

As a young, ambitious and independent woman, Beulah successfully secured her first employment opportunity as an Insurance Agent in her hometown, Washington, GA. Soon thereafter, Beulah would meet the love of her life, Sergeant Herbert Barnett Wiggins who was stationed in Georgia while serving in the United States Army. Following her marriage to Sergeant Wiggins in October 1950, Beulah began traveling around the world with her husband. Through the years the couple would affectionately refer to each other as "My Partner" and "My Friend". In later years their love code words would become "I Got You". This blessed union of sixty-four years produced five children whom she adored and nurtured while instilling in them the knowledge of Jesus Christ. The family eventually settled in New Jersey.

In 1960, Beulah became a faithful member of the Pleasant Grove Baptist Church of Newark, New Jersey, however, she later united with the Jehovah-Jireh Praise & Worship Church Center under the Leadership of Bishop Rudy V. and Lady Linda L. Carlton.

Although employed as a seamstress and beautician, Beulah would later pursue her passion in serving others as a Nurse's Aide for the Newark Beth Israel Hospital, Newark, NJ for over thirty years until her retirement.

By responding to the voice of Almighty God, on Monday, February 2, 2015, Beulah peacefully slipped in the Master's arms and joined her parents who both preceded her in death.
