William H. Woods, Sr. son of JoAnna Woods and Joe Harris was born April 1, 1938 in Caswell County, NC. He was the oldest of five children. He is preceded in death by his great grandmother, Betty Jane who raised him, his mother, JoAnna; wife, Evanligest Louise Lee Woods; biological son, Billie Long Woods; uncles, Will and John,

who raised him; his sisters, Maggie, Shirley, Willie Swann.

In his formative years, he attended Caswell County Training School and graduated in 1955. In Yancerville, NC "Willie" as he was affectionately called joined the Armed Forces in 1959. He attended the Newark Deliverance Bible Institute in 1962, Iona College in 1964, other Bible Institutes and graduated from Liberty Bible School in 2009. He received an Honorary Doctorate Degree in 2013. Willie held various jobs and later started his own Swimming Pool Business named Lou Wood Pools in New Rochelle, NY. The business was successful until 2005 when he retired.

He accepted the Clarion call to the Ministry when he and his late wife, Evangelist Louise Lee Woods established the Celestial Pentecostal Church in Mount Vernon, NY.
