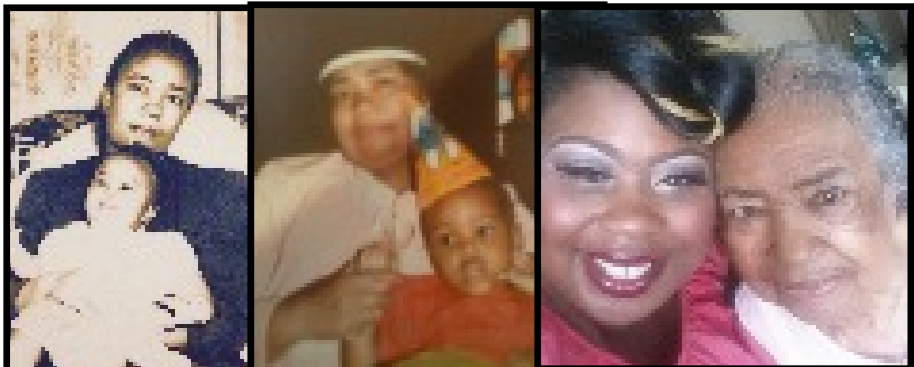
She came to Christ at an early age, when she became a member at Mt. Sinai Baptist Church, until she moved to Newark, NJ.
