**Teresa McDonald** was born June 9, 1955 in Dothan, Alabama. She departed from us on February 10, 2015.

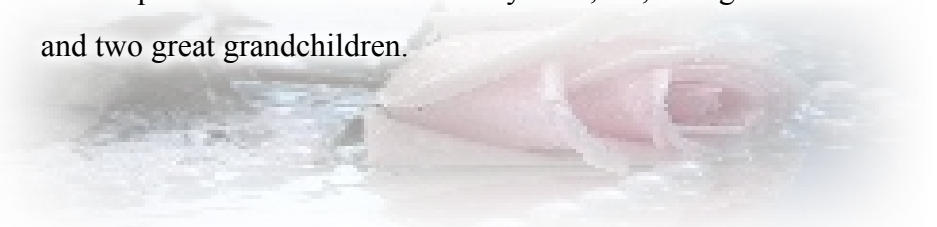
Teresa was a Home Health Aide, she worked at Personal Touch and Jersey Shore Medical Center.
