<u> Obituary</u>

Willis Conaway was born May 4, 1936 in Egypt, Georgia. He attended grammar school and high school in Sanford, Florida where he had a paper route at the age of twelve. During his formative years it was realized by his Mom, Natalie Conaway that he was on the path to being a task master. One day he came in from school and noticed that his Mom had not come home yet. Upon her arrival he said in his most stern five year-old voice, "the next time you're going to be late, you have to be sure to leave me a note".

Willis had a love of learning and maintained excellent grades. After graduating from High School he attended the University of Florida A & M as an English Major. To say he was an articulate wordsmith was an understatement. He worked as a Disc Jockey for WTMP in Tampa, Florida. Affectionately referred to as Mumbo Slim, he was known for cutting a rug and being the center of attention.

Mr. Conaway came to New Jersey with his late wife, Lillian in the early 1960s with aspirations of pursuing a career as a radio DJ. Willis and Lillian had six children (Brian Conaway, Natalie Conaway (Thomas), Derwin Conaway, Valerie Conaway, Kelvin Conaway, and Dennis Conaway. He enjoyed taking his children to the park, playing board games and listening to music. His favorite genre was Jazz, and Nina Simone was his favorite Jazz vocalist. Mr. Conaway was a very proud man, and teaching his children about Black History was of paramount importance as part of his parenting.

Mr. Conaway had a great work ethic, a commitment to excellence and a fruitful work history. The various employers include; JC Penney Department store (worked eight years throughout high school and college). He worked as a Manager for the Prudential Insurance Company in the Corporate Expense Department (twenty plus years) while working part-time for Bamberger's Department Store in the Men's Department (fifteen years). This store is now referred to as Macy's Department Store. After the landscape of Corporate America began to change, he opted to begin another career with NJ Transit as a bus operator (twenty-five years).

Mr. Conaway is survived by his mother, Natalie Conaway and brother, Johnelle Conaway. In addition to his six children his legacy includes seventeen grandchildren, eighteen great-grandchildren and a plethora of nieces, nephews and children who held a special place in his heart.

Willis Conaway departed this life February 9, 2015 at his home in Iselin, New Jersey. He will be truly missed by all who love him.
