Albertine Spears Obituary

Mrs. Albertine Spears was born on August 29, 1922 in Concord, North Carolina. She has one brother, Edward Harris, who resides in Roselle, New Jersey and a sister, Ivey Spears, residing in Harrisburg, North Carolina. She attended Barber-Scotia College in Concord, North Carolina.

Mrs. Albertine Spears and Ellis Spears married in 1941 in Charlotte, North Carolina. After marriage, the Spears family relocated to Newark, New Jersey. She attended the Abyssinian Baptist Church in Newark, New Jersey.

After moving to Rahway in 1952, she joined the Second Baptist Church in 1954 under the pastorate of Reverend Winfred C. Moss. Her love for music led her to join the formerly Inspiration Choir, now the Church Inspirational Choir. She was a charter member of the choir and Parent-Teachers Club. She was active in the Women's Guild, Missionary Society, Mass Choir and also sang with the 100 plus women in White. She was also past chairperson of the Church Anniversary Committee and past member of the Pastor's Anniversary Committee. During the Women's Day service on Sunday, September 28th, 2014, the Women's Guild for the first time honored those women 80 years and older. Mrs. Spears was one.

On Recognition Sunday, November 6, 2014, Mrs. Spears received a "Special Honoree Recognition" for being a 60 year member. She also supported all areas of the church programs.

In addition to her church, she was an active member of the Rahway NAACP and attended the Rahway Senior Center.

Mrs. Spears enjoyed traveling. She was a very lively and outgoing person.

Mrs. Spears was pre deceased by: her husband, Ellis Spears, and one daughter, Marie Williams. She leaves to cherish her memories, one daughter, Delores Kenon (John); two sons, Leonard Spears (Gwen) and Harry Spears; one brother, Edward Harris; one sister, Ivey Spears; grandchildren, great grandchildren, and a host of other relatives and friends.
