Howard Fred Bell known to many as "**Ding Dong**" was born on August 6, 1935 in Cheyenne, Wyoming to the late Howard Paul and Dorothy Marie Jones-Bell of Cheyenne. Howard attended the Cheyenne Public School system. Graduating from Cheyenne High school in 1954, he held records in wrestling, track, basketball and was exceptional in football. On November 4, 1956, Howard Bell was honorably discharged from Airman basic #187 Air National Guard. He attended Colorado State Teacher's College in Greeley, Colorado presently the University of Northern Colorado; Howard also attended Seton Hall University in South Orange, New Jersey.

Howard was a member of Berean Baptist Church, was ordained Deacon in 1997.

Howard taught the Montgomery Street, and 18th Ave. School in the City of Newark, he loved children and had a special anointing when teaching and giving correction to the students. Howard was also a City Inspector in the City of Newark. He coached football at Central High and Weequahic High School. He retired from Essex County youth house as a Senior Intake Officer in 1994, after suffering a stroke. He continued to enjoy familiar things with limitations. He loved his family, friends and church family.

Howard was an adventurous man with a perpetual fond smile that exchanged a stranger to a friend. Howard was generous, loving spirited, kind-hearted, held an optimist view and never looked at the negative. His favorite phrase was "Everything is in Divine Order". He enjoyed traveling, be it by car, boat, train or plane. As many of us know dancing was his forte, "Lean Back".

In the early 1960's Howard moved from Cheyenne, Wyoming to Newark, New Jersey where he met and married the late Ms. Marion Harris of that union two children were born, and later moving to Fanwood, New Jersey, where he lived for many years. In 1997, he married Ms. Jean M. Jackson, that adding many extended children and grandchildren.

Howard's dialysis was difficult but never complained. On Sunday, March 8, 2015 at 9:02 a.m. at Robert Wood Johnson Hospital in Rahway, NJ, GOD spoke and took Howard home to be with Him, but through all health issues God brought him through and we are so grateful and filled with confidence knowing that we can face the future as God is with us, so we pause today and give God all the praise for all you are and all you do.
