Jason Lloyd Allwood was born on January 26, 1982, to Grace and Ricardo Allwood, Sr. He emanated joy from infancy until the day he died. Seared in memory are varied images from the wide-open, toothless grin and eyes full of merriment to the beguiling smile he carried throughout his life.

Jason attended Sage Garden Academy, New Covenant School, DeWitt Clinton High School, Evander Childs High School and Hostos College. He then enlisted in the United States Army. There he served until his medical discharge following his diagnosis of Chronic Myeloid Leukemia.

Jason never yielded to the powerful, debilitating side effects of chemotherapy. He chose instead to write and record music. His towering priority however, was the upbringing and nurturing of his sons, Latrell Nesta Allwood and Michael Andrew Allwood. Major decisions proceeded from careful evaluation of potential impact to his sons. Prime examples include his decision to relocate to Florida and coach middle school and high school basketball. Latrell loved and still loves the sport and excelled at it through his father's coaching. Michael thrived with the best care from both his parents.

On March 12, 2015, Jason, the perennial peacemaker, had the misfortune of parting a fight between individuals with whom he had no acquaintance, later resulting in a bullet that shattered his courageous heart. Jason Lloyd Allwood died on March 13, 2015. He leaves to mourn his children, Latrell Nesta Allwood and Michael Andrew Allwood, his parents, Grace Bewry Allwood Burrowes and Ricardo Anthony Allwood, Sr., brothers, Ricardo Anthony Allwood, Jr., Kadeem Anthony Allwood and Brandon Cecil Burrowes, his grandfather, the Rev. Lloyd Otto Bewry, aunts, uncles and a host of beloved cousins and friends.

He will be laid to rest at the Calverton National Cemetery on March 23, 2015. We will warm ourselves by the eternal flame of his life until we reunite in the presence of the Father of Mercies, God of all comfort.
