## *Obituary*

**Maude Ree Shackelford Daniels** was born to the late Louis and Martha Shackelford on May 31, 1915 in Chipley, Florida. She was the last surviving child of a total of seventeen children. She was raised in the African Methodist Episcopal Church and received her elementary schooling in DeSota City, Florida. As a young adult, she moved to Harlem, New York where she completed her education and earned a nursing degree specializing in radiology while working odd jobs during the day.

On October 18, 1952, she was wed in holy matrimony to the late Edward Clarence Daniels and relocated to Bronx, NY. Although living in the Bronx, Mother Daniels enjoyed many nights in the clubs of Harlem. She eventually heard the call of Lord on her life and converted to Catholicism and served diligently in her local parish. After many years of dedication in her local parish, Mother Daniels still felt a void and eventually was invited to the Greater Refuge Temple, Church of Our Lord Jesus Christ by her niece, Gwendolyn Shackelford where she was water baptized on January 22, 1975 and received the gift of the Holy Spirit.

Mother Daniels served faithfully in her church and attended the Church of Christ Bible Institute. She was proud to have served as a Sunday School teacher, in the Outreach Ministries and Foreign Missions that resulted in her traveling to Monrovia, Liberia, West Africa.
