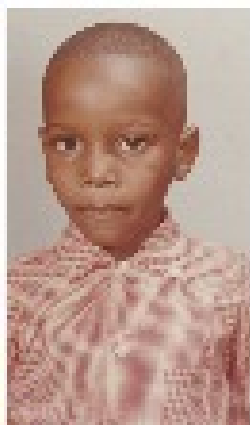
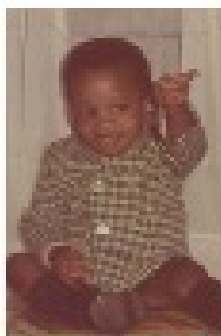
Obituary
