Michael went on to attend Virginia State University following high school, where he obtained a B.A. in Political Science, and Howard Law School where he obtained his Juris Doctorate. While attending Howard University, Attorney Winston was recognized by the **Association of Trial Lawyers of America (ATLA)** for excellence in trial advocacy after winning ATLA's regional trial competition (Virginia, Maryland, North Carolina) and placing second nationally.
