Beatrix Adarlo Fernandez was born on March 25, 2015 at Newark Beth Israel Medical Center to Sharon Adarlo and David Fernandez. She departed this world on April 9, 2015 at the same hospital.

Beatrix was born premature at 24 weeks on a Wednesday at 11:19 a.m. and

weighed 410 grams and measured 9 and 3/4 inches. She had long eyelashes, big black eyes, and fuzzy eyebrows. She had the same nose as her father and the long limbs characteristic of her mother's side of the family. She was small but had a feisty personality. She annoyed her nurses because she liked to move around a lot in her isolette.

Beatrix was perfect but born early because her mother developed preeclampsia at 23 weeks gestation. Sharon was put on strict hospital bed rest and managed to keep Beatrix in her womb for a week to give her a fighting chance at life.

Beatrix gave out a cute squeal after an emergency C-section, which prompted one of the nurses to nickname her "Squirrel". Her

other nicknames were "Little Cabbage" and "Little B".

Beatrix had an amazing group of doctors and nurses who kept her going for two weeks. Her father and mother visited her every day, talked to her and read her books. She had many visitors, including her devoted lolas, who loved her very much. They talked to her and sang her songs, including *Twinkle Twinkle Little Star*, which Beatrix liked very much.

Beatrix unfortunately took a turn for the worst one day after her two-week birthday. She had a faltering heart rate and low oxygen saturation levels. Sharon and David finally got to touch, hug and kiss their daughter for the first time as Beatrix took her last breath
