Julius “Spencer” Johnson was born on May 12, 1923 in Lusby, Maryland to the late William and Sarah Johnson. After a lengthy illness Spencer departed this life quietly on Thursday, April 9, 2015.

Spencer was educated in the school systems of Calvert County, Maryland as a young child. He held various jobs in the local community after graduating high school, until he entered the U.S. Army on May 7, 1943. Spencer served his country in World War II, until he received an Honorable Discharge in December of 1945. After his military career, Spencer was employed with Demassi Cadillac for thirty-two years. There he was an enthused and devoted employee until his retirement.

Spencer met the love of his life, Myrtle, at a very young age. They were united in holy matrimony on January 22, 1950. There were no children born to this marriage, however they lovingly cared for and nurtured Rosalind E. Glover (deceased) as their own. Spencer had a passion for fishing and eating oysters. He was meticulous with his cars and clothes, and he was quite the snazzy dresser. He enjoyed baseball and was a Mets fan. He also enjoyed quartet singing.
