Reflections of Life

On July 28, 1932, the sunrise of life began for Carrie Mae Paige in Greenville, GA (Meriwether County). One of two children, she was nurtured and raised by her loving Mother Mourrene Parks, who is now deceased. At an early age, she was introduced to the Church and Fellowship of Believers in the White Plains Church of White Plains, GA. Here, she confessed her faith in Jesus Christ.

Carrie attended school in the Meriwether County School System. She later took academic courses at Passaic County Community College, Paterson, NJ. The loving wife of Deacon Henry T. Paige, who preceded her in death, they shared a life as entrepreneurs and community servants for more than fifty years. She served as a Registrar with the Paterson Election Board for several decades.

As a long-time resident of the City of Paterson, Carrie Paige was known by many residents. For several years she was a Sales Clerk at Historic Jacob's Department Store on Main Street in Downtown Paterson. She will always be regarded and remembered as a cheerful, courteous and persuasive clerk who greeted every customer with a "Smile for the Sale Mile."

With her continued commitment to Christ and Christian Service, Sister Carrie Paige was an Early Founding Member of Christ Church United Methodist, Paterson, NJ. She was totally dedicated to the mission and ministry of the church where her active participation included: Secretary and Treasurer of the United Methodist Women; Pastor Parish Relations Committee; Trustee Board; and the Administrative Council. For every local and public church program, Sister Paige could be counted on for financial promotion and community participation. Christ Church was a "Living Testimony" in her very being and supportive existence.

On May 1, 2015, after an extended period of illness, Sister Carrie Mae Paige met her Sunset of Life.
