Luretta Russell Pringle was the daughter of Alexander Russell and Mattie Woodard. She was born October 12, 1917 in Winnsboro, South Carolina. Luretta departed this life June 13, 2015; she was 97 years young.

Luretta was married at age 18 to James Ashford Sr. She gave birth to her one and only child, James Jr. in 1936. Luretta left her home in the late 1950s and moved to the city of Newark, NJ. She worked for the V.A. Hospital in Lyons, NJ as a nurse's aide for two years. Luretta inherited her business sense from her father, Alexander Russell, who was the 1st black embalmer, funeral home owner and director in the south.

Luretta pursed her vision to own, operate and manage her own businesses around the city of Newark around the mid 1960s. These businesses ranged from grocery stores to restaurants. During that same time period Luretta became interested in becoming a foster parent.

Luretta met Willie Pringle after the death of her first husband, James Ashford Sr., and the two were married years later. Luretta loved being a grandmother and foster mother. She also enjoyed holidays, summer cookouts and church functions. She loved the art of cooking for others. Luretta was a champion to her community and she was well respected. Helping the less fortunate in society was her *true calling*, from feeding the homeless to being a mother to those that were motherless.

Luretta became an active member of Christian Pentecostal Church in Irvington, NJ in the late 1980s under the leadership of Dr. Willie L. Smith. She raised approximately 17 foster children during her time as a foster mother.

Luretta was preceded in death by her mother, Mattie Woodard, son, James Ashford Jr., adopted son, Askia "Ski" Pringle, brother, Aaron Woodard, and both of her husbands, James Ashford Sr. and Willie Pringle.

Luretta leaves to cherish her memory: her daughter-in-law, Jessie M. Ashford; five grandchildren, Victoria, Tracie, Leon, Alonzo and Larry Ashford; adopted sons, Omar and Excel Pringle; sister-in-law, Anna Belle Puryear; 15 great grandchildren and 12 great-great grandchildren; and a host of great nieces, nephews, cousins and many friends. She will truly be missed.
