Obituary

Henrietta Stowell was born on December 1, 1912 to the late Keifur Thomas and Henrietta Blakely in Seneca, South Carolina.

She migrated to New Jersey with her family at the early age of two. Upon reaching school age, she attended public schools in Newark, East Orange, and Harrison. Her mother brought her to Mt. Olivet Baptist Church in 1926 and she was baptized by Rev. W.W. Fleming in 1928. Henrietta's many decades of devotion included serving as secretary of BYPU and singing in both the junior and senior choirs.

She retired from General Motors after twenty-five years working as an inspector, wrapper, and machine operator. A lifetime member of the Oziel Chapter, Order of the Eastern Star Trinity Chapter No. 14 (PHA), she was inducted into the Centenarian Club at 100 years of age.
