<u>Obituary</u>

James W. Robinson, age sixty-six, passed away at his home, on Saturday, September 3, 2016. He was born on November 21, 1949 in Roper, NC, the son of James and Jessie Pearl Robinson.

He was a 1960's graduate of West Side High School Newark, NJ and attended Minnesota State University, Mankato, Minnesota receiving a Bachelor of Arts Degree in Psychology in the 1980's. He worked as a Mental Health and Treatment Adherence Counselor and spearheaded the very first outreach program of NJCRI in Newark, NJ, which became an asset to the community and a much needed program to improve community outreach services. James inspired people to admit even the toughest truths to themselves, and to develop plans to improve their quality of life. James never took any wooden nickels that life so often offers the naïve.

James was one of the last soldiers to be drafted into the military, and served three tours of duty during the Vietnam War from 1971 to 1974 receiving an Honorable Discharge.

James leaves to cherish his memory: his beloved wife, Ennis Robinson; two daughters, Sabre Burroughs and Tamika Robinson; five sons, Nigel Robinson, Ahmeen Burroughs, Dushant Robinson, Jason Folsom and Ki Newhouse; three sisters, Karnell Norman, Sandra Dunbar and Amelia Robinson; two brothers, Ronell Norman and Larry Norman. He is also survived by five grandchildren a host of nieces, nephews, other relatives and friends.
