Deacon William Floyd Little was born on December 17, 1927 in Robbinsville, NC to Winnie and Jessie Little, and resided in Paterson, NJ for many years.

Deacon Little was a praying and anointed man of God. He enjoyed praying for people. He was a singer, who often visited singing groups to help the tenor section. The groups included the Voices of Faith, and the Gospel Servants of which he was a member with Deacon King. He was a Commissioner for Passaic County Office of the Aging along with Vernon Allen. Deacon Little was employed by Paterson Paper as a Truck Driver for many years. He also was employed by R.C.A. repairing televisions. He was a business man, and loved people.
