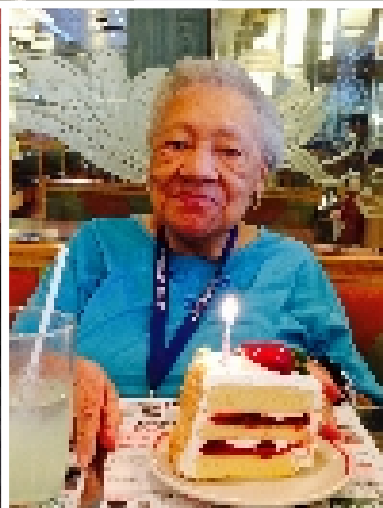
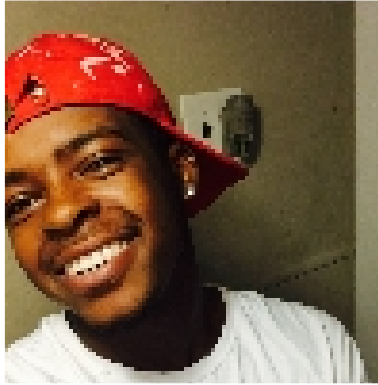
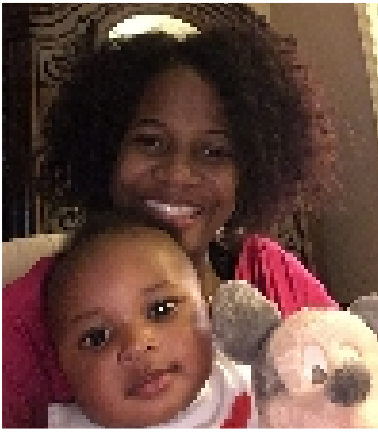


With Love To My Wife For All You Mean To Me
