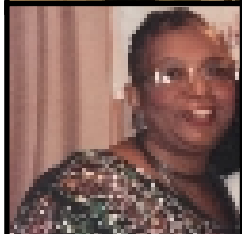
Doris E. Prescott

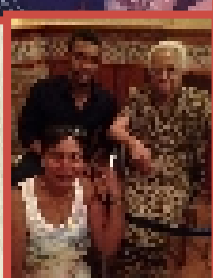
Come To Me
