Life Sketch

Pamella Delores Germain, affectionately known as Miss Tom, Big J or Pam peacefully departed this earthly life on March 7, 2026, at the age of 78. She was the beloved fifth child of the late Cecil and Daisy Germain, born on July 14, 1947, in the district of Carnie, St. Ann, Jamaica, West Indies.

Growing up as a child in the district of Carnie she dedicated her time to the Carnie Tabernacle Church under the leadership of Pastor Joseph Prendergast where she accepted the Lord as her personal savior. She was baptized at the age of fourteen and became the youth coordinator for the church Sunday School and sang in the youth choir.

Pamella embarked on her educational journey at the Clydesdale Primary School, which she successfully completed, paving the way for her enrollment at the Aboukir High School where she continued to pursue her educational goals.

Pamella relocated to Kingston to pursue her dreams of joining the Jamaica Constabulary Force (JDF). However, an opportunity to migrate to the United States of America to join her sister Beverly was presented. Pamella, although reluctant to leave her siblings and parents, accepted the challenge.

Upon coming to America, Pamella continued her christian journey at the Shiloh Apostolic Church located in Queens, New York and in later years she attended services at Grace United Methodist Church located in St. Albans, New York with some of her other siblings.

Pamella was employed with the Jim Dandy Dry Cleaners, Queens, New York when an opportunity was presented for her to pursue employment with Dry Harbor Nursing Home, Woodside, NY. Once again Pamella met the challenge and remained employed with Dry Harbor from May 5, 1979, until her retirement on May 30, 2014. Pamella also maintained seasonal employment with the United States Postal Service and in later years with the New York Board of Elections.

Her favorite pastime was reading her Bible, and the Upper Room for her daily devotion. Pamella loved to dance, bake, play volleyball, Bingo, and solve crossword puzzles. Most of all Pamella loved being a mother to her devoted sons Kareem and Christopher.
