

OBITUARY

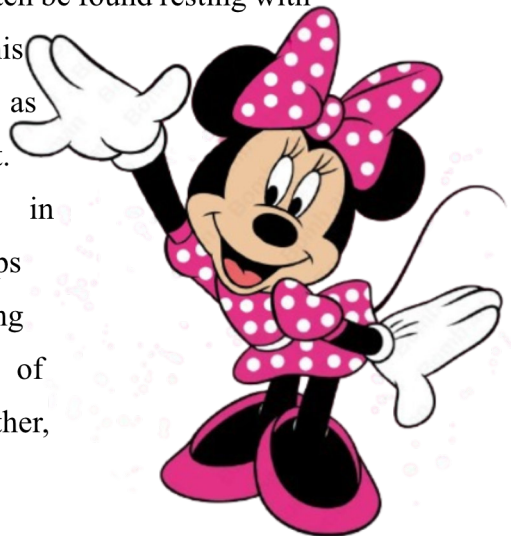

Kaori also loved playing with cell phones, especially because they brought daily calls from all her grandparents, who greeted her each morning and wished her goodnight each evening.

in your hearts I'll always stay.*

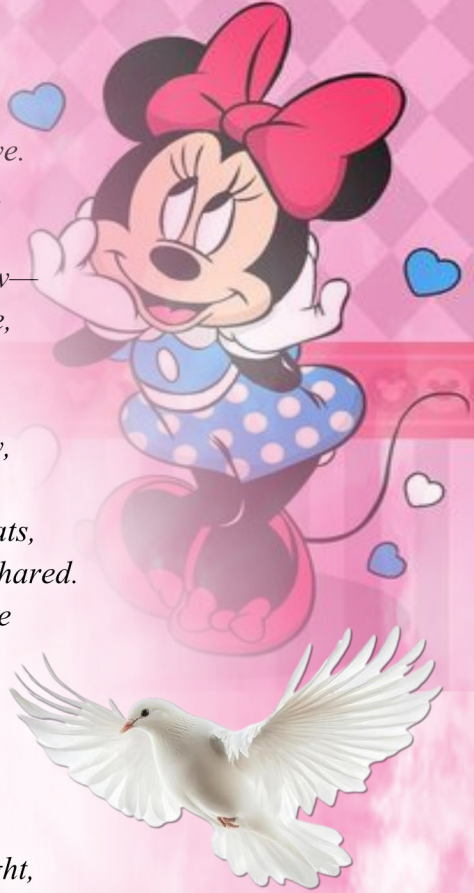
*Please don't hold only the sorrow—
