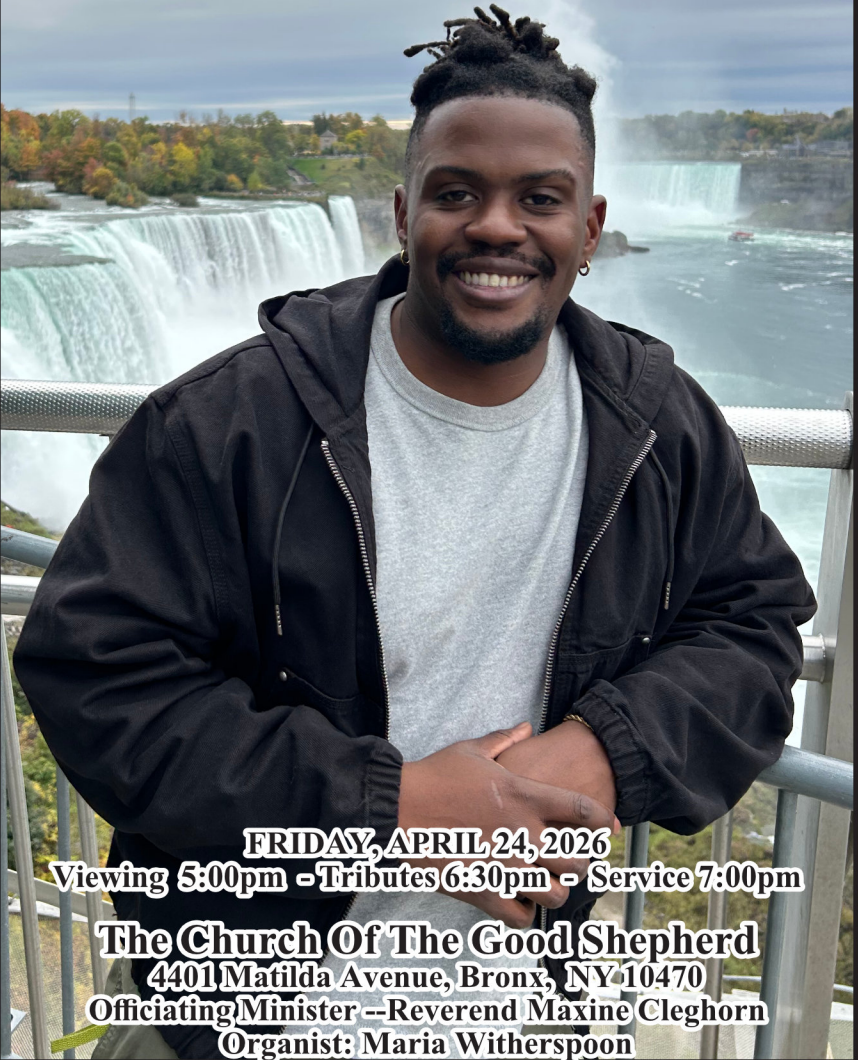

# Obituary

**Kristopher Gallimore**, born February 10, 1994, passed from this life on March 29, 2026, leaving behind a legacy defined by love, generosity, and presence highlighted by his understated swagger. His time on earth, though far too short, was filled with purpose, connection, and a devotion to the people and passions that shaped him.

Faith shaped Kris from a young age. He was confirmed here at the Church of the Good Shepherd, where he served as an acolyte, youth leader, and steel pan player. He attended Sunday School weekly and participated in CEDMA during the summers, forming bonds and memories that stayed with him throughout his life. His service to the church reflected the same spirit he carried everywhere—humble, joyful, and rooted in love.

Kris graduated from Ohio Wesleyan University with his bachelor's degree, carrying forward a curiosity and discipline that would guide his professional life. He built a meaningful career as a general manager and movement specialist at Perform for Life San Francisco and Perform for Golf San Francisco, where he poured his heart into helping others grow stronger—physically, mentally, and personally. His colleagues, clients, and the athletes he trained remember him not only for his expertise, but for his steady handed leadership, encouragement, patience, and genuine care that he had for everyone. As a child of Jamaican heritage, he could not just have one job, he was also the athletic trainer for the International School of San Francisco where he passionately developed the skills, hearts and minds of young athletes.

Besides being the cool uncle and the best gift giver, Kris was also known for his love of music and his love of family and friends. He had a natural ability to connect with children and was passionate about fitness, fashion, and reading. He approached life with a full heart. He loved deeply, listened fully, and welcomed everyone with his great smile. His presence was steady, grounded, and unforgettable.

Those who remain to cherish his memory include his parents, Sonia Livingstone and Basil Gallimore, along with a wide circle of family and friends who were profoundly shaped by his warmth and unwavering loyalty.

Kristopher's life was a testament to compassion, dedication, and the quiet power of showing up for others. His memory will continue to inspire all who knew him to live with the same intention and love that he embodied so naturally.
