Don't Cry For Me

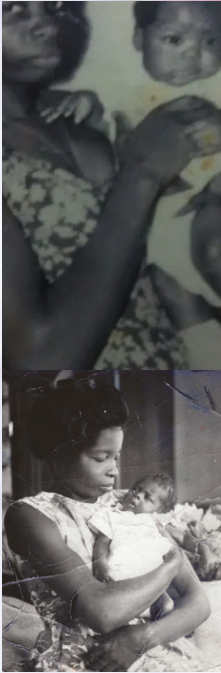
*Do not cry for me, for I have lived my life
