# O bituary

Carrie (Blunt) Anderson was born to George and Fannie Blunt on Sunday, July 15, 1928 at Harlem Hospital, NY. She was the fourth of twelve children.

Carrie grew up on the Eastside of Harlem, where she attended school and graduated.

In June of 1947, she married James Anderson, she birthed eight children.

Carrie's first apartment was a kitchenette on 126th street. We later moved to the first apartment in Harlem River Houses (2637 7th Avenue) in 1951.

Carrie had several jobs: a jewelry store worker, a dietician at Mt. Sinai, a decorator, and most challenging, raising and being an unpaid therapist to her children (all with different personalities and needs), as well as helping raise her grandchildren.

Carrie always enjoyed cooking, reading her bible and other things, music, and dancing. She frequently went to the Savoy Manor where her husband would find men lining up to dance with her. In recent years, Carrie loved going shopping or giving her children a list of items to pick up, eating food she enjoyed, watching certain TV programs, constantly listening to her music, and spending time and celebrating with family.

Carrie had a full abundant life. On Thursday, April 23, 2026, at the age of Ninety-Seven (\*97\*), she passed away at The Hudson Pointe in Riverdale, NY.

Carrie leaves to mourn her, brother, William Blunt; children, Claudia, Rochelle, Vickie, Bevelynn, Melvin, and Tracey; grandchildren, Nikole, Jason, Jemaine, and Michael; great grandchildren, Izaiah, Nyazha, and Jada; and a host of nieces, nephews, and other family members.
