Reflections of Life for Louis Glover Jr.

The life force that filled **Louis Glover Jr.** shifted to a whisper and then silence on the calm Sunday evening of April 26th, 2026. As he took his last breath, he faithfully lived out his vow of fifty years of “until death do us part” comforted by the presence of the love of his life Sadie Lee Glover (Fortune) by his side.

Louis Glover Jr., fondly known to loved ones as “Buddy” was born on January 2, 1943, in Jeffersonville, Georgia to Louis Glover Sr. and Ida (Paul) Glover. His family roots were steeped in southern values of community that were common in the southern states.
